The AVID site team is excited to announce that we will be having three tutors come in and assist our AVID students in any academic needs they have. The tutors will be on campus Mondays, and Wednesdays from 8:00a.m. to 11:20 a.m., and Thursdays from 8:00a.m. to 9:14 a.m. in the AVID classrooms.

Our Freshman AVID students are working on preparation for AVID tutorials. They participated in jigsaw activities in small groups, watched AVID on demand tutorial videos of demo schools, took Cornell notes and collaborated in pairs to compare their notes and fill in any gaps where they might have missed information.

The Junior AVID class is starting to study for both the AP and SAT exams. The students have been introduced to different speakers to help them decide which career path they should go into. Finally, the Senior AVID students are researching/applying to a variety of scholarships. Our 32 seniors submitted over 120 college applications. All 32 have completed the FASFA, and we are currently in the process of securing scholarships

This year, we are preparing for our first annual AVID field trip to multiple colleges. The students will have a chance to see what college is all about, including classes that they might attend as well as school surroundings. We will also be starting an AVID club for those students who did not receive the initial opportunity to be part of AVID. The club will support students in their academic achievement.
