The book also provides concrete strategies on how to help students to manage their stress in healthy ways rather than indulging in unhealthy behaviors.

The book looks at the 7 C's of resilience which include:

-Competence -Contribution

-Confidence -Coping

-Connection -Control

-Character

I have communicated with Dr. Ginsburg and he has given me permission to share with my parent community information about the 7 C's in our newsletter. Each month I will focus on one of these C's and explain what it is, how we are implementing it at Soledad High school, and how you can reinforce what we are teaching at home to ensure that all of our students leave school with the skills necessary to lead healthy, productive lives.
