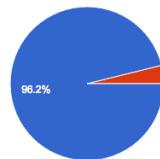

Intervention Survey

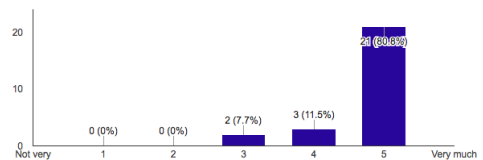

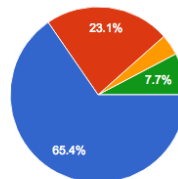
Would you recommend this group to another friend/peer? (26) How relevant and helpful were the topics you learned about? (26 responses)
