Goal I - Increased Graduation Rate

- Host a College Day for students to highlight local colleges.

- In the Spring, host an 8th Grade Parent Night that welcomes new parents and explains the Soledad High School programs available.
- Provide a summer Bridge Program for incoming freshmen students to prepare them to begin their high school careers.
- Train a group of students to participate in the Link Crew program as mentors to incoming freshmen.
- Provide college trips to Hartnell College, CSUMB, and UCSC to allow students to see all three levels of public post-secondary education available.

Goal II - Proficiency for All

- Provide tutoring support to students outside the confines of the traditional school day.
- Provide students access to college and career preparation curriculum through the Get Focused/Stay Focused program.
- Provide supplemental materials and supplies for core content classes.

Goal III - School Safety

- Sustain the PBIS program to promote and maintain student attendance and positive student behaviors.
- Implement a restorative justice (RJ) program at Soledad High School to allow students to participate in RJ practices when involved in behavioral incidents at SHS.
- Purchase supplies to increase safety within the classroom and on the site as a whole.

- Provide coach stipends for student activities & music supplies to support music programs for K-12.
- Improve communication with parent groups (such as ELAC, & School Site Council) in home language.
- Increase translation services available for Parent Conferences.
